About The Awards

Nehru Sidhant Kender Trust instituted the Sat Paul Mittal Awards in 1992 in fond memory of its Founder President Late Shri Sat Paul Mittal, who selflessly worked for the upliftment of the poor. Shri Mittal's perseverance and zeal in promoting new ideas in population control, world peace and development was recognised by the United Nations with the prestigious United Nations Peace Medal in 1987.

Posterity shall gratefully remember the significant contributions made by Shri Mittal in giving direction to the parliamentary movement in promoting basic awareness and understanding of population and human survival issues in the world.

- **Sat Paul Mittal National Awards (Platinum)** is given every year to an individual(s) and institution(s) rendering outstanding service to humanity and carries an amount of Rs 7.5 lacs each.
- **Sat Paul Mittal National Awards (Gold)** is given every year to an individual(s) and institution(s) rendering outstanding service to humanity and carries an amount of Rs 2.5 lac each.

Eligibility Criteria

- The Awards are given every year to individual(s) and institution(s) rendering outstanding service to humanity.
- The Awards are open to all individual(s) and institution(s).
- Nominations should be sent in the prescribed format.
- The decision of the Awards Jury shall be final.

Nominations

The nominations must include background information, field of activity, research, measurable outcomes, impact on individuals & society and other achievements of the nominee.
